Dear Family and Friends,

On behalf of everyone at Wellsville Manor Care Center, I hope this week's family letter finds you well. Within this week's letter, we will discuss our current COVID-19 status, updates on our construction projects occurring within and outside the facility, and important updates we want you all to be aware of. Wellsville Manor Care Center is officially COVID-19 free! Our facility has 0 residents and 0 staff who are positive for COVID-19. The residents who tested positive in late May and early June have since completed their isolation/quarantine, and have resolved all COVID-19 symptoms. The staff member who tested positive on 6/12/2022 has completed their furlough from work, and has since returned with resolved symptoms and a negative COVID-19 test. Our facility currently only has 3 residents on isolation/quarantine with transmission-based precautions due to their vaccination status upon admission. We currently have 0 residents and 0 staff under investigation for COVID-19. Wellsville Manor Care Center is currently in the process remodeling our resident common areas and administrative offices through renovations and construction. We are currently focused on our main lobby and administrative offices, so please be on the look out for warning signs or caution tape, and follow all signage appropriately. We are also planning for the implementation of our new emergency generator, hopefully occurring in mid-July or early August. We have blocked off the construction area with caution barriers, so please use caution when arriving to the facility and remain distant from construction areas. If you have any questions regarding the facility construction efforts, please feel free to call the facility at 585-593-4400.

Wellsville Manor Care Center wants to ensure all family members and friends are up to date with our facility policies regarding infection control. Please be sure to share this information to other family members and friends, as only the main representative for our residents receive this family letter. Our facility still requires all visitors to wear surgical masks upon arrival to the facility, and for the duration of your visit. Masks must remain on at all times, especially while in the resident room, as this is one of our facility's defenses against COVID-19. Please also ensure to keep at least 6 feet distance from all other residents or staff members while visit, when feasible. And finally, **please remember that food and drinks are not allowed while visiting**, as you must keep you mask on at all times. Wellsville Manor Care Center appreciates all of the support and understanding we have received form our residents and our family members. We wish you all the best in the days to come, and hope to see everyone soon.
